### **Health Foundation Impact Investments**



In 2022, the Health Foundation made a **\$1M impact investment in** the Florida Community Loan Fund (FCLF), which provides flexible capital and staff expertise to low-income communities across Florida.

The **South Florida Community Land Trust** directly benefited from the Health Foundation's impact investment approach. With financing from the FCLF, South Florida Community Land Trust purchased land for a future 200-unit multifamily development in Miami's Overtown neighborhood.



MIAMI HOMES FOR ALL The Health Foundation sponsored the Miami Homes for All housing pipeline analysis to assess the Miami affordable housing needs, and the pipeline needed to address these needs.
